

# CHECKPOINT 1 ▶▶▶ CHECKPOINT 2

**CP 1** 阿弥陀寺  
Amidaji

**CP 2** 箱根芦之湯フラワーセンター  
Hakone Ashinoyu Flower Center

- ① 阿弥陀寺駐車場 (CP1) を出て右 (来た道) に戻り、左手の階段を下る。  
(注意: お地藏さんに触れないように)
  - ② 階段を下りて車道を鋭角に右折し塔之沢駅方面に坂を下る
  - ③ 突き当たり右手奥の階段を下る
  - ④ 突き当たり「アショカの道」看板を左折し下る
  - ⑤ 階段を下りて左折し車道端から歩道に入り進む
  - ⑥ トンネル(函嶺洞門)を通過し、橋の前の横断歩道を渡り、車道右端を進む
  - ⑦ 右側の「湯坂路」の看板より細い階段を上がりハイキングコースを進む
  - ⑧ 石畳を進む
  - ⑨ 樹林帯の切り開かれたエリア
  - ⑩ 浅間山方面に進む
  - ⑪ 浅間山山頂を過ぎてすぐを鷹巣山方面へ左折
  - ⑫ 鷹巣山を過ぎ道なり
  - ⑬ 「飛竜の滝」方面には進まず直進
  - ⑭ 車道に突き当たり、左折し歩道を進む
  - ⑮ ガソリンスタンド裏を進む
- ➔ 箱根芦之湯フラワーセンターが CP2

- ① From Amidaji parking area (CP1), follow the road down, then follow the curve around to the left. Go down the stairs and continue towards Tonosawa station “塔之沢駅”. (NB: Please take care not to touch the Jizo statue).
- ② Go down the stairs and make a sharp turn to the right onto the road, continue downhill towards Tonosawa station “塔之沢駅”.
- ③ At the end of the road, go down the back set of stairs on the right.
- ④ When you come to the end, turn left at the Ashoka-no-michi Trail “アショカの道” sign, continue down.
- ⑤ At the bottom of the stairs turn left, and enter the footpath from the side of the road.
- ⑥ Go through a tunnel “函嶺洞門 (Kanrei Domon)”, cross the pedestrian crossing in front of the bridge and continue along the right-hand side of the road.
- ⑦ On the right you will see a sign for Yusakamichi Trail “湯坂路”. From here go up the narrow stairs and continue along the hiking trail.
- ⑧ Follow the stone footpath.
- ⑨ Cross the clearing in the woods.
- ⑩ Continue towards Mt. Sengen. “浅間山”.
- ⑪ After passing the summit of Mt. Sengen, turn left towards Mt. Takanosu. “鷹巣山”.
- ⑫ Pass Mt. Takanosu and continue along the path.
- ⑬ Do not go towards Hiryu-no-taki waterfall, “飛竜の滝” continue straight along the path.
- ⑭ Continue to the end of the road. Turn left and follow the footpath.
- ⑮ Walk behind of the gas station.

➔ CP2 is at Hakone Ashinoyu Flower Center “箱根芦之湯フラワーセンター”

## 阿弥陀寺 (Amidaji)

皇女和宮の位牌がまつられています。  
6月中旬から7月上旬にかけて、参道から本堂までの山道の両側には3000株の紫や青、白いあじさいが咲き乱れます。このアジサイはすべて、現在の住職が自ら手植えされたものです。

Amidaji enshrines the ancestral tablet of Princess Kazunomiya. From mid June to mid July, the mountain trail leading to the main temple building becomes a riot of colour, due to the 3000 blooming hydrangea plants, all of various shades of purple, blue, and white, lining its path. All 3000 of which were personally planted by the current chief priest of the temple.
